MAINTENANCE AND TESTING OF PORTABLE FIRE ...

NFPA 10(10), Section 724 requires that records be kept of all extinguishers inspected, including those needing corrective action The date the inspection was performed and the initials of the person performing the inspection must be recorded on a tag or label attached to each extinguisher, on an inspection checklist maintained on file ,
